Arnold H McLeod School, in partnership with Anglophone East School District and Chartwells Canada, is proud to be continuing our reduced-cost school lunch program. AHM students will be able to purchase a hot lunch from the cafeteria each day for \$3.25. The menu is attached to this message, and each day includes a main course, a side dish, a beverage, and some fruit. For example, chicken snack wrap and salad, fruit, and choice of milk.

Each day you will find one meal selection and one alternate meal. These are the only two options.

The program will officially begin on **Monday, October 7th**. Please use https://www.chartwellsk12.com or download the Nutrislice App to order. Order monthly, weekly, or daily before 8:00 a.m. Currently, only online orders are accepted and are due by 8:00 a.m. Cancellations must also be made daily by 8:00 a.m.

Please note that meals are the only item sold in the cafeteria and must be pre-ordered. Individual items such as milk are not available to buy separately at this time.
